

## Massachusetts: District 10

### The Need for Services

- 19,620 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Massachusetts's 10th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 15 family planning clinics in Massachusetts's 10th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 8 are run by community health centers and 7 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 8,470 women, including 2,520 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 19% are served by community health centers and 81% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 10 of the family planning clinics in Massachusetts's 10th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 7 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Massachusetts's 10th congressional district serve 7,980 women, including 2,400 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 14% are served by community health centers and 86% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 10th congressional district.*
