

## Massachusetts: District 2

### The Need for Services

- 37,930 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Massachusetts's 2nd congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 16 family planning clinics in Massachusetts's 2nd congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 7 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 7 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 13,090 women, including 4,140 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 36% are served by hospitals, 8% are served by Planned Parenthood, 5% are served by community health centers and 52% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 8 of the family planning clinics in Massachusetts's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 6 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Massachusetts's 2nd congressional district serve 7,470 women, including 2,420 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 9% are served by community health centers and 90% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
