

Massachusetts: District 3

The Need for Services

- 30,540 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Massachusetts's 3rd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 9 family planning clinics in Massachusetts's 3rd congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 5 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 12,000 women, including 2,230 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 42% are served by hospitals, 23% are served by Planned Parenthood, 13% are served by community health centers and 22% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 4 of the family planning clinics in Massachusetts's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 4 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Massachusetts's 3rd congressional district serve 2,310 women, including 860 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 100% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
