

Massachusetts: District 4

The Need for Services

- 29,730 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Massachusetts's 4th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 6 family planning clinics in Massachusetts's 4th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 5 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 6,450 women, including 2,520 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 5% are served by community health centers and 95% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in Massachusetts's 4th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 4 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Massachusetts's 4th congressional district serve 4,450 women, including 2,020 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 7% are served by community health centers and 93% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 4th congressional district.*
