

Michigan: District 1

The Need for Services

- 36,240 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Michigan's 1st congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 50 family planning clinics in Michigan's 1st congressional district. 30 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 13 are run by community health centers and 4 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 19,830 women, including 6,420 teenagers.* 65% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 22% are served by Planned Parenthood, 11% are served by community health centers and 2% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 32 of the family planning clinics in Michigan's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 30 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Michigan's 1st congressional district serve 17,060 women, including 5,710 teenagers.* 76% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 24% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
