

Michigan: District 10

The Need for Services

- 20,720 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Michigan's 10th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 14 family planning clinics in Michigan's 10th congressional district. 12 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 7,430 women, including 2,320 teenagers.* 92% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 1% are served by community health centers and 6% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 12 of the family planning clinics in Michigan's 10th congressional district are supported by Title X. 12 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Michigan's 10th congressional district serve 6,860 women, including 2,240 teenagers.* 100% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 10th congressional district.*
