

Michigan: District 12

The Need for Services

- 23,590 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Michigan's 12th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 7 family planning clinics in Michigan's 12th congressional district. 3 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 11,590 women, including 4,000 teenagers.* 51% are served by health departments, 15% are served by hospitals, 34% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in Michigan's 12th congressional district are supported by Title X. 3 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Michigan's 12th congressional district serve 9,860 women, including 3,410 teenagers.* 60% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 40% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 12th congressional district.*
