

Michigan: District 13

The Need for Services

- 80,500 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Michigan's 13th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 12 family planning clinics in Michigan's 13th congressional district. 3 are run by health departments, 5 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 14,930 women, including 5,140 teenagers.* 37% are served by health departments, 47% are served by hospitals, 10% are served by Planned Parenthood, 6% are served by community health centers and 1% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in Michigan's 13th congressional district are supported by Title X. 3 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Michigan's 13th congressional district serve 7,940 women, including 1,920 teenagers.* 69% are served by health departments, 12% are served by hospitals, 19% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 13th congressional district.*
