

## Michigan: District 15

### The Need for Services

- 42,590 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Michigan's 15th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 8 family planning clinics in Michigan's 15th congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 2 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 14,500 women, including 3,590 teenagers.\* 10% are served by health departments, 11% are served by hospitals, 75% are served by Planned Parenthood, 3% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 4 of the family planning clinics in Michigan's 15th congressional district are supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Michigan's 15th congressional district serve 12,420 women, including 3,110 teenagers.\* 12% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 88% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 15th congressional district.*
