

Michigan: District 2

The Need for Services

- 31,390 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Michigan's 2nd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 22 family planning clinics in Michigan's 2nd congressional district. 7 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 6 are run by community health centers and 5 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 16,370 women, including 5,400 teenagers.* 40% are served by health departments, 16% are served by hospitals, 19% are served by Planned Parenthood, 16% are served by community health centers and 9% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 11 of the family planning clinics in Michigan's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 7 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Michigan's 2nd congressional district serve 12,330 women, including 4,270 teenagers.* 54% are served by health departments, 21% are served by hospitals, 25% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
