



Michigan: District 3

The Need for Services

- 31,450 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Michigan's 3rd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 13 family planning clinics in Michigan's 3rd congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 1 is run by a hospital, 6 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 25,350 women, including 8,270 teenagers.* 4% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 86% are served by Planned Parenthood, 8% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 7 of the family planning clinics in Michigan's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 6 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Michigan's 3rd congressional district serve 22,950 women, including 7,620 teenagers.* 5% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 95% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
