

Michigan: District 4

The Need for Services

- 39,390 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Michigan's 4th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 27 family planning clinics in Michigan's 4th congressional district. 16 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 3 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 23,220 women, including 7,820 teenagers.* 54% are served by health departments, 2% are served by hospitals, 40% are served by Planned Parenthood, 2% are served by community health centers and 1% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 17 of the family planning clinics in Michigan's 4th congressional district are supported by Title X. 14 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Michigan's 4th congressional district serve 21,400 women, including 7,040 teenagers.* 56% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 44% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 4th congressional district.*
