

Michigan: District 5

The Need for Services

- 49,540 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Michigan's 5th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 14 family planning clinics in Michigan's 5th congressional district. 5 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 6 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 18,100 women, including 5,370 teenagers.* 45% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 30% are served by Planned Parenthood, 24% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 7 of the family planning clinics in Michigan's 5th congressional district are supported by Title X. 5 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Michigan's 5th congressional district serve 13,570 women, including 4,370 teenagers.* 60% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 40% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 5th congressional district.*
