

## Michigan: District 6

### The Need for Services

- 43,000 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Michigan's 6th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 25 family planning clinics in Michigan's 6th congressional district. 12 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 7 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 26,750 women, including 8,470 teenagers.\* 37% are served by health departments, 3% are served by hospitals, 27% are served by Planned Parenthood, 24% are served by community health centers and 8% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 18 of the family planning clinics in Michigan's 6th congressional district are supported by Title X. 12 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Michigan's 6th congressional district serve 20,310 women, including 6,070 teenagers.\* 49% are served by health departments, 4% are served by hospitals, 36% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 11% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 6th congressional district.*
