

Minnesota: District 1

The Need for Services

- 33,710 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Minnesota's 1st congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 20 family planning clinics in Minnesota's 1st congressional district. 2 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 12 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 14,890 women, including 6,110 teenagers.* 2% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 75% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 22% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 14 of the family planning clinics in Minnesota's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 9 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Minnesota's 1st congressional district serve 14,020 women, including 5,670 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 80% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 20% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
