

## Minnesota: District 2

### The Need for Services

- 15,200 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Minnesota's 2nd congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 7 family planning clinics in Minnesota's 2nd congressional district. 2 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 2 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 5,840 women, including 1,700 teenagers.\* 12% are served by health departments, 2% are served by hospitals, 77% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 9% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 1 of the family planning clinics in 2nd congressional district is supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Minnesota's 2nd congressional district serve 1,200 women, including 600 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 100% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
