

Minnesota: District 4

The Need for Services

- 39,730 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Minnesota's 4th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 16 family planning clinics in Minnesota's 4th congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 1 is run by a hospital, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 7 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 21,630 women, including 6,350 teenagers.* 17% are served by health departments, 4% are served by hospitals, 17% are served by Planned Parenthood, 32% are served by community health centers and 30% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 1 of the family planning clinics in 4th congressional district is supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Minnesota's 4th congressional district serve 3,670 women, including 780 teenagers.* 100% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 4th congressional district.*
