

Minnesota: District 5

The Need for Services

- 52,820 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Minnesota's 5th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 18 family planning clinics in Minnesota's 5th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 6 are run by community health centers and 7 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 19,150 women, including 4,550 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 22% are served by hospitals, 29% are served by Planned Parenthood, 14% are served by community health centers and 35% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 3 of the family planning clinics in Minnesota's 5th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Minnesota's 5th congressional district serve 2,790 women, including 1,410 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 21% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 79% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 5th congressional district.*
