

Minnesota: District 7

The Need for Services

- 37,360 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Minnesota's 7th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 43 family planning clinics in Minnesota's 7th congressional district. 6 are run by health departments, 6 are run by hospitals, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 25 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 15,190 women, including 5,840 teenagers.* 2% are served by health departments, 5% are served by hospitals, 65% are served by Planned Parenthood, 1% are served by community health centers and 27% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 11 of the family planning clinics in Minnesota's 7th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 6 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Minnesota's 7th congressional district serve 11,310 women, including 4,450 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 87% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 13% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 7th congressional district.*
