



Missouri: District 1

The Need for Services

- 51,950 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Missouri's 1st congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 16 family planning clinics in Missouri's 1st congressional district. 2 are run by health departments, 4 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 8 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 17,270 women, including 4,150 teenagers.* 15% are served by health departments, 21% are served by hospitals, 40% are served by Planned Parenthood, 24% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 11 of the family planning clinics in Missouri's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Missouri's 1st congressional district serve 14,720 women, including 3,180 teenagers.* 17% are served by health departments, 13% are served by hospitals, 47% are served by Planned Parenthood, 22% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
