

Missouri: District 3

The Need for Services

- 35,380 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Missouri's 3rd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 11 family planning clinics in Missouri's 3rd congressional district. 3 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 9,430 women, including 2,270 teenagers.* 16% are served by health departments, 27% are served by hospitals, 27% are served by Planned Parenthood, 31% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 8 of the family planning clinics in Missouri's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Missouri's 3rd congressional district serve 8,450 women, including 1,940 teenagers.* 16% are served by health departments, 20% are served by hospitals, 30% are served by Planned Parenthood, 34% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
