

Missouri: District 4

The Need for Services

- 35,220 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Missouri's 4th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 32 family planning clinics in Missouri's 4th congressional district. 14 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 11 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 8,850 women, including 2,520 teenagers.* 39% are served by health departments, 4% are served by hospitals, 33% are served by Planned Parenthood, 2% are served by community health centers and 21% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 14 of the family planning clinics in Missouri's 4th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 10 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Missouri's 4th congressional district serve 4,690 women, including 1,370 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 62% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 38% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 4th congressional district.*
