



Missouri: District 5

The Need for Services

- 42,400 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Missouri's 5th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 16 family planning clinics in Missouri's 5th congressional district. 3 are run by health departments, 4 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 4 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 14,230 women, including 3,500 teenagers.* 7% are served by health departments, 2% are served by hospitals, 66% are served by Planned Parenthood, 16% are served by community health centers and 9% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in Missouri's 5th congressional district are supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Missouri's 5th congressional district serve 8,460 women, including 2,210 teenagers.* 7% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 86% are served by Planned Parenthood, 6% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 5th congressional district.*
