

Missouri: District 6

The Need for Services

- 27,980 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Missouri's 6th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 34 family planning clinics in Missouri's 6th congressional district. 5 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 9 are run by community health centers and 19 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 11,980 women, including 3,060 teenagers.* 8% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 19% are served by Planned Parenthood, 7% are served by community health centers and 66% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 20 of the family planning clinics in Missouri's 6th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 19 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Missouri's 6th congressional district serve 10,250 women, including 2,630 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 22% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 78% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 6th congressional district.*
