

Missouri: District 7

The Need for Services

- 43,410 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Missouri's 7th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 16 family planning clinics in Missouri's 7th congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 10 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 12,280 women, including 2,770 teenagers.* 3% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 55% are served by Planned Parenthood, 2% are served by community health centers and 40% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 10 of the family planning clinics in Missouri's 7th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 10 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Missouri's 7th congressional district serve 4,940 women, including 1,180 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 100% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 7th congressional district.*
