

## Missouri: District 8

### The Need for Services

- 52,970 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Missouri's 8th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 44 family planning clinics in Missouri's 8th congressional district. 13 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 10 are run by community health centers and 20 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 11,930 women, including 3,020 teenagers.\* 22% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 13% are served by Planned Parenthood, 4% are served by community health centers and 61% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 19 of the family planning clinics in Missouri's 8th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 18 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Missouri's 8th congressional district serve 8,150 women, including 2,000 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 20% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 80% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 8th congressional district.*
