

Missouri: District 9

The Need for Services

- 39,840 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Missouri's 9th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 26 family planning clinics in Missouri's 9th congressional district. 6 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 7 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 7 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 14,240 women, including 3,630 teenagers.* 6% are served by health departments, 6% are served by hospitals, 44% are served by Planned Parenthood, 8% are served by community health centers and 36% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 15 of the family planning clinics in Missouri's 9th congressional district are supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 7 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 7 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Missouri's 9th congressional district serve 11,500 women, including 2,920 teenagers.* 1% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 54% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 45% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 9th congressional district.*
