

Montana: at-large

The Need for Services

- 54,990 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Montana's at-large congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 61 family planning clinics in Montana's at-large congressional district. 24 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 29 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 33,920 women, including 9,670 teenagers.* 25% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 41% are served by Planned Parenthood, 3% are served by community health centers and 30% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 35 of the family planning clinics in Montana's at-large congressional district are supported by Title X. 20 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 9 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Montana's at-large congressional district serve 28,820 women, including 8,330 teenagers.* 26% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 48% are served by Planned Parenthood, 2% are served by community health centers and 25% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in at-large congressional district.*
