

Nebraska: District 2

The Need for Services

- 32,720 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Nebraska's 2nd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 13 family planning clinics in Nebraska's 2nd congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 4 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 14,710 women, including 3,420 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 9% are served by hospitals, 69% are served by Planned Parenthood, 6% are served by community health centers and 16% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 10 of the family planning clinics in Nebraska's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 3 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Nebraska's 2nd congressional district serve 13,820 women, including 3,200 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 10% are served by hospitals, 73% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 17% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
