

Nebraska: District 3

The Need for Services

- 35,570 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Nebraska's 3rd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 17 family planning clinics in Nebraska's 3rd congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 6 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 10 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 10,950 women, including 2,910 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 17% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 13% are served by community health centers and 71% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 16 of the family planning clinics in Nebraska's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 5 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 10 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Nebraska's 3rd congressional district serve 10,690 women, including 2,840 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 14% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 13% are served by community health centers and 72% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
