



Nevada: District 1

The Need for Services

- 47,960 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Nevada's 1st congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 10 family planning clinics in Nevada's 1st congressional district. 3 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 5 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 21,970 women, including 4,760 teenagers.* 56% are served by health departments, 6% are served by hospitals, 18% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 19% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 6 of the family planning clinics in Nevada's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 3 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 3 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Nevada's 1st congressional district serve 13,570 women, including 2,820 teenagers.* 91% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 9% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
