

Nevada: District 2

The Need for Services

- 35,250 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Nevada's 2nd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 41 family planning clinics in Nevada's 2nd congressional district. 19 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 10 are run by community health centers and 8 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 18,080 women, including 3,450 teenagers.* 42% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 50% are served by Planned Parenthood, 4% are served by community health centers and 3% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 21 of the family planning clinics in Nevada's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 19 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Nevada's 2nd congressional district serve 16,640 women, including 3,050 teenagers.* 46% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 54% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
