

## New Hampshire: District 1

### The Need for Services

- 32,770 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New Hampshire's 1st congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 15 family planning clinics in New Hampshire's 1st congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 6 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 5 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 16,190 women, including 5,300 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 55% are served by Planned Parenthood, 14% are served by community health centers and 31% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 12 of the family planning clinics in New Hampshire's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 6 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 5 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New Hampshire's 1st congressional district serve 13,880 women, including 4,730 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 64% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 36% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
