

New Hampshire: District 2

The Need for Services

- 30,070 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New Hampshire's 2nd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 20 family planning clinics in New Hampshire's 2nd congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 7 are run by community health centers and 6 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 14,490 women, including 5,050 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 15% are served by hospitals, 49% are served by Planned Parenthood, 26% are served by community health centers and 10% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 19 of the family planning clinics in New Hampshire's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 7 are run by community health centers and 6 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New Hampshire's 2nd congressional district serve 14,020 women, including 4,920 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 12% are served by hospitals, 51% are served by Planned Parenthood, 26% are served by community health centers and 10% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
