

New Jersey: District 1

The Need for Services

- 36,870 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New Jersey's 1st congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 12 family planning clinics in New Jersey's 1st congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 12,060 women, including 3,150 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 28% are served by hospitals, 35% are served by Planned Parenthood, 21% are served by community health centers and 17% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 6 of the family planning clinics in New Jersey's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New Jersey's 1st congressional district serve 6,210 women, including 2,160 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 68% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 32% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
