

New Jersey: District 10

The Need for Services

- 64,560 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New Jersey's 10th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 9 family planning clinics in New Jersey's 10th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 18,230 women, including 4,380 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 33% are served by hospitals, 67% are served by Planned Parenthood, 1% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in New Jersey's 10th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New Jersey's 10th congressional district serve 15,800 women, including 4,270 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 23% are served by hospitals, 77% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 10th congressional district.*
