

New Jersey: District 11

The Need for Services

- 11,810 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New Jersey's 11th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 5 family planning clinics in New Jersey's 11th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 9,470 women, including 1,710 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 5% are served by hospitals, 74% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 21% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 3 of the family planning clinics in New Jersey's 11th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New Jersey's 11th congressional district serve 9,040 women, including 1,600 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 78% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 22% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 11th congressional district.*
