

New Jersey: District 13

The Need for Services

- 66,640 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New Jersey's 13th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 10 family planning clinics in New Jersey's 13th congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 2 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 22,550 women, including 3,740 teenagers.* 5% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 38% are served by Planned Parenthood, 40% are served by community health centers and 17% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 8 of the family planning clinics in New Jersey's 13th congressional district are supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New Jersey's 13th congressional district serve 21,810 women, including 3,570 teenagers.* 6% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 39% are served by Planned Parenthood, 38% are served by community health centers and 17% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 13th congressional district.*
