

## New Jersey: District 2

### The Need for Services

- 35,280 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New Jersey's 2nd congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 13 family planning clinics in New Jersey's 2nd congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 3 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 4 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 10,020 women, including 3,400 teenagers.\* 15% are served by health departments, 17% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 37% are served by community health centers and 31% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 8 of the family planning clinics in New Jersey's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 3 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 4 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New Jersey's 2nd congressional district serve 6,320 women, including 2,060 teenagers.\* 23% are served by health departments, 27% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 49% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
