

## New Jersey: District 3

### The Need for Services

- 17,110 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New Jersey's 3rd congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 7 family planning clinics in New Jersey's 3rd congressional district. 3 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 3,770 women, including 1,060 teenagers.\* 35% are served by health departments, 5% are served by hospitals, 43% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 16% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 6 of the family planning clinics in New Jersey's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 3 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New Jersey's 3rd congressional district serve 3,570 women, including 1,010 teenagers.\* 37% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 46% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 17% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
