

## New Jersey: District 4

### The Need for Services

- 20,650 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New Jersey's 4th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 6 family planning clinics in New Jersey's 4th congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 6,840 women, including 1,910 teenagers.\* 1% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 51% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 48% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in New Jersey's 4th congressional district are supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New Jersey's 4th congressional district serve 6,820 women, including 1,900 teenagers.\* 1% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 52% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 48% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 4th congressional district.*
