

## New Jersey: District 7

### The Need for Services

- 11,760 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New Jersey's 7th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 4 family planning clinics in New Jersey's 7th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 3,110 women, including 1,050 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 15% are served by hospitals, 85% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 2 of the family planning clinics in New Jersey's 7th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New Jersey's 7th congressional district serve 2,640 women, including 940 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 100% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 7th congressional district.*
