

## New Mexico: District 1

### The Need for Services

- 34,290 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New Mexico's 1st congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 32 family planning clinics in New Mexico's 1st congressional district. 8 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 6 are run by community health centers and 14 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 23,370 women, including 5,060 teenagers.\* 10% are served by health departments, 17% are served by hospitals, 36% are served by Planned Parenthood, 10% are served by community health centers and 27% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 19 of the family planning clinics in New Mexico's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 8 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 10 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New Mexico's 1st congressional district serve 6,720 women, including not available teenagers.\* 34% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 8% are served by community health centers and 58% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
