

## New Mexico: District 2

### The Need for Services

- 51,770 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New Mexico's 2nd congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 60 family planning clinics in New Mexico's 2nd congressional district. 24 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 23 are run by community health centers and 11 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 20,890 women, including 5,740 teenagers.\* 58% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 8% are served by Planned Parenthood, 24% are served by community health centers and 9% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 31 of the family planning clinics in New Mexico's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 24 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New Mexico's 2nd congressional district serve 13,010 women, including not available teenagers.\* 94% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 5% are served by community health centers and 1% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
