

New Mexico: District 3

The Need for Services

- 41,330 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New Mexico's 3rd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 76 family planning clinics in New Mexico's 3rd congressional district. 18 are run by health departments, 8 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 37 are run by community health centers and 11 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 24,250 women, including 6,530 teenagers.* 20% are served by health departments, 22% are served by hospitals, 12% are served by Planned Parenthood, 40% are served by community health centers and 5% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 43 of the family planning clinics in New Mexico's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 18 are run by health departments, 5 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 13 are run by community health centers and 7 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New Mexico's 3rd congressional district serve 14,840 women, including 4,520 teenagers.* 33% are served by health departments, 35% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 26% are served by community health centers and 6% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
