



New York: District 1

The Need for Services

- 17,210 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New York's 1st congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 10 family planning clinics in New York's 1st congressional district. 5 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 15,500 women, including 4,000 teenagers.* 27% are served by health departments, 8% are served by hospitals, 65% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 9 of the family planning clinics in New York's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 5 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New York's 1st congressional district serve 14,200 women, including 3,680 teenagers.* 29% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 71% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
