

New York: District 10

The Need for Services

- 81,310 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New York's 10th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 22 family planning clinics in New York's 10th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 15 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 2 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 24,200 women, including 6,670 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 62% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 16% are served by community health centers and 22% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 3 of the family planning clinics in New York's 10th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New York's 10th congressional district serve 6,180 women, including 1,540 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 38% are served by community health centers and 62% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 10th congressional district.*
