

## New York: District 11

### The Need for Services

- 68,050 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New York's 11th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 12 family planning clinics in New York's 11th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 9 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 22,930 women, including 5,370 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 55% are served by hospitals, 40% are served by Planned Parenthood, 5% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 2 of the family planning clinics in New York's 11th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New York's 11th congressional district serve 7,720 women, including 1,100 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 88% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 12% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 11th congressional district.*
