

## New York: District 12

### The Need for Services

- 80,220 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New York's 12th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 17 family planning clinics in New York's 12th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 9 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 6 are run by community health centers and 2 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 16,970 women, including 3,480 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 38% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 34% are served by community health centers and 28% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 2 of the family planning clinics in New York's 12th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New York's 12th congressional district serve 3,410 women, including 740 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 34% are served by community health centers and 66% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 12th congressional district.*
