

New York: District 15

The Need for Services

- 85,020 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New York's 15th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 11 family planning clinics in New York's 15th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 4 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 2 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 24,250 women, including 4,820 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 58% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 28% are served by community health centers and 14% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 6 of the family planning clinics in New York's 15th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New York's 15th congressional district serve 18,200 women, including 3,660 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 72% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 15% are served by community health centers and 13% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 15th congressional district.*
